CTE Month: Equity as a Guiding Principle



Building Trust to Promote Equity in CTE - Advance CTE released a brief focused on equity in Career Technical Education. [*Making Good on the Promise: Building Trust to Promote Equity in CTE*](#), describes steps state leaders can take to rebuild trust in marginalized communities that CTE has historically failed to equitably serve. It examines strategies that states are using to communicate the promise of CTE and gain buy-in from within state agencies, from communities and from stakeholders to promote equity in CTE. CTE Gateway to Equity - The Office for Community College Research and Leadership (OCCRL) conducted an exploratory case study of CTE programs that made noticeable gains in supporting underrepresented and underserved students and what structures and practices were implemented in order to strive for equity. There are apparent inequities in terms of who

gets access to certain fields and the requisite CTE training that leads to economic and lifelong advancement. In the state of Illinois approximately 32% of those participating in postsecondary CTE programs are members of a racial minority group, and between 2010 and 2014, there was a slight increase in CTE participation and completion across all racial minority groups, with the exception of Pacific Islander according to the [Underrepresented Students Report](#). However, nationally Black and Latinx workers are still more likely to be situated in low-paying fields such as community services and arts, and food and personal services, whereas, White and Asian workers are more likely to work in higher-paying, growth sectors like STEM and healthcare and other technical occupations.
