

### A quick reminder re: NRS...

- A student is included in the NRS outcomes if...
  - the student earns at least 12 attendance hours prior to leaving the program
    - If in a fixed entry class, the student must also successfully reach the midterm point to be claimable
  - is not a VOC only or Foreign Language GED student
  - has been properly pre-tested
  - has selected a Primary Goal
  - and is free from all errors as determined by DAISI's error checking system


# A snapshot of ABE enrollment patterns for the National Reporting System







### ABE Enrollment, PY 2000-01 through PY 2008-09







# A snapshot of ASE enrollment patterns for the National Reporting System












# A snapshot of ESL enrollment patterns for the National Reporting System









### ESL Enrollment, PY 2000-01 through PY 2008-09








### Percent of Students Pre and Posttested, 2008-09







## Change in Number of ABE/ASE Student Completers between PY 2004-05 and PY 2008-09











## Change in Number of ESL Student Completers between PY 2004-05 and PY 2008-09






Percent of ESL Student Completers, by State, PY 2008-09




