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What curriculum is:

Curriculum outlines the skills, performances, attitudes, and values [students] are expected to learn from schooling. It includes statements of desired [student] outcomes, descriptions of materials, and <u>the planned sequence that will be</u> <u>used to help [students] attain the outcomes</u>

What curriculum is:

- Spiral Curriculum: Many ideas are introduced at each grade/level and then repeated at following grades to add depth of understanding.
- Outcome Based Curriculum: Students study a topic in depth until it is mastered. The question of "what is mastery?" needs to be answered if using this model.

What curriculum <u>isn't</u>:

• A scripted text of lessons and activities to be performed in every classroom.

Where we are now:

• FY12 - Aligned the Illinois ABE/ASE Content Standards with the Common Core State Standards

• October 2013 - Aligned the Illinois ABE/ASE Content Standards with OVAE's College and Career Readiness Standards.

Where we are now:

The Curriculum Development Project:

- Ten programs were selected to participate
 - ABE/ASE programs, High School Credit, Department of Corrections, CBO
- One ABE team & one ASE team
- Teams meet monthly to develop essential understandings and essential questions for each group of ABE/ASE content standards

Where we are now (continued):

• Draft Curriculum Guide submitted to ICCB for approval - April 2014

• Reviewed and finalized - May 2014

Where we are headed:

- June 2014 ABE/ASE Curriculum Institutes will be held across the state
 - Mandatory training for all ICCB-funded programs that serve ABE and/or ASE students
 - Date/location of training will be preselected (will be grouped regionally to minimize travel)
