ICCB Program Recommendations for TABE 11 & 12 Implementation

All ICCB-funded ABE/ASE Programs are required to use TABE 11 & 12 as of January 1, 2019.

- ➤ The Locator is lengthened **slightly** to make it more predictive in placing students into the new TABE 11 & 12. The Locator is important to the validity of the TABE 11 & 12. Consider testing time and materials needed for intake of students.
- ➤ The allowable time for TABE 11 & 12 is **longer**, so considerations should be made for potential impact to intake and/or post-testing procedures.
- Consider implementing the Computer-Based Testing or Scanning option for ease of use, increased accuracy, and reporting platform. (Students and test administrators can use the Online Tools Training to become familiar with the online platform.)
- The new TABE demonstrates the necessity for standards-based instruction across all levels of Adult Education. It is vital that you communicate information about increased rigor and standards alignment to all staff. If you have not been integrating the Illinois ABE/ASE standards into your teaching, you must begin because the TABE 11 & 12 is aligned to these standards. If you do not begin applying standards-based instruction, your program's TABE post-test scores, student gains, and performance dollars may suffer.
