**Introduction**

This *Addendum* contains supplemental instructions and reporting requirements for community colleges to address in their Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Reports. Information regarding the completion of Parts A and B, which are standard items in the annual report, is included in the *Community College PQP/Program Review Guide* (December 1993). Each year as a part of the Accountability/Program Review reporting process, the colleges have been asked to respond in Parts C and D of their reports to special inquiries based on issues from the Illinois Board of Higher Education and the Illinois Community College Board state-level initiatives.

**Please note the following changes for the Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Report:**

- 1. Part C does not include focus questions. The Results Report requested annually by the Illinois Board of Higher Education will request colleges to address some additional items that are consistent with areas of focus for ICCB. Therefore, the focus questions were eliminated from Part C of the Accountability/Program Review Report to avoid duplicate reporting. IBHE has not yet issued guidelines for the 2003 Results Report. ICCB will distribute the guidelines to colleges as soon as they are available.**
- 2. Part D - The Review of Undergraduate Education is no longer required.**

This *Addendum* includes instructions for preparing reports related to:

- Instructional program review summaries (Part A).
- Action summaries of programmatic improvements (Part B).
- Information from the *2002 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2001 Occupational Program Graduates* (Part C).

The *Addendum* also contains the following attachments that should be helpful as the colleges pursue their Accountability/Program Review activities:

- Attachment 1 – schedule for occupational program review.
- Attachment 2 – tables that show statewide information on credit hours, unit costs, enrollments, and completions by college for the instructional program areas that are to be reviewed during the year. Colleges will also find it useful to reference the tables included in the ICCB report, *2002 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2001 Occupational Graduates*, when analyzing program reviews.

**Three copies of the Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Report should be submitted to the ICCB no later than August 1, 2003. For your convenience, a checklist of all the items that are to be included in the report is included on pages 4 and 5.**

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003 ACCOUNTABILITY/PROGRAM REVIEW REPORT**

### **Part A: Instructional Program Review Summaries (Analyses)**

Colleges should use the *Community College PQP/Program Review Guide* (December 1993) for directions for Part A of the report. The following forms from Part A should be included in the Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Report from the college:

#### Form A-1 for occupational programs

A separate Form A-1 should be completed for each occupational program scheduled for review during fiscal year 2003. A schedule of the programs to be reviewed each year is attached for your use. In addition, a Form A-1 should be completed for any occupational program that was reviewed during fiscal year 2002, and for which further review was indicated. (Attachment 2 - ICCB Occupational Program Review and Attachment 3 - Data tables of enrollments, completions, credit hours, and program costs are included for reference and/or for use in analyzing program review results.)

#### Form A-2 for academic disciplines

A separate Form A-2 should be completed for each academic discipline reviewed during fiscal year 2003.

#### Form A-3 for developmental education

A separate Form A-3 should be completed for each developmental program reviewed during fiscal year 2003. Developmental programs include Adult Basic and Adult Secondary Education, English as a Second Language, and Developmental Studies.

Other: Form A-4 for Academic and Student Support Programs, Form A-5 for Overall Academic Functions, Form A-6 for Administrative Functions, and Form A-7 for Public Service Functions should be submitted only if the college reviewed the relevant functional area during fiscal year 2003.

**IMPORTANT: While the primary purpose of program review is to ensure that programs are of high and continuing quality, the process is also a critical means of being accountable to students and others. The summaries of program reviews should provide strong evidence that recommendations for quality improvements for programs are linked directly to the findings of a rigorous program review process. In addition, summaries of program reviews should provide a continuous accountability loop by including information regarding the outcome(s) of recommendations from the previous review of each program.**

### **Part B: Action Summaries of Programmatic Improvements**

Colleges should use the *Community College PQP-Program Review Guide* (December 1993) for directions for Part B of the report. The following form from Part B should be included in the Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Report:

Form B-1 for actions taken in the instructional program area as the result of the year's formal program reviews, prior years' reviews, or informal reviews.

Other: If the college submits Form A-4, A-5, A-6, or A-7, the corresponding Form B action summary should also be submitted.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Forms for Part B of the report should be submitted in hardcopy only. **Part B no longer needs to be submitted in computer-readable form.**

### **Part C: Occupational Program Reviews – Analysis of Information from the 2002 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2001 Occupational Program Graduates**

This section of the *Accountability/Program Review Report* calls for an institutional analysis of information presented in the *Follow-Up Study of Occupational Graduates* distributed to the community college system each October. The follow-up study contains responses obtained from occupational program graduates of selected programs on a standardized student survey, thereby providing a critical "customer" perspective. Data from the survey are an important consideration as colleges evaluate the need, quality, and cost of specific occupational curricula during program review. Graduate response rates must be strong for these evaluations to be meaningful. *Therefore, minimum response rates have been set: a 50 percent response rate must be achieved by those colleges surveying 30 or more graduates; a 60 percent response is required for those institutions contacting less than 30 graduates.*

**Colleges that did not meet the appropriate criterion for the survey of fiscal year 2000 occupational graduates should give special attention to increasing these rates for the coming year. These colleges should provide a brief update on their efforts to increase response rates as Part C of their Fiscal Year 2002 Accountability/Program Review Report.**

**Issues identified for particular programs in the 2002 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2001 Occupational Program Graduates should be addressed in individual program review summaries (Section A-1), as appropriate.**

### **Five-Year Schedule of Program Reviews**

The college should submit a copy of its current five-year schedule of program reviews.

- NOTE:** If a college indicated further review for a program that was reviewed in fiscal year 2002, please include a Form A-1 for the program to indicate the results of the continued review.
- Part B:** Form B-1 for actions taken in the instructional program area as the result of the past year's formal program reviews, prior years' reviews, or informal reviews
- If Form A-4, A-5, A-6, or A-7 is submitted, the corresponding Form B action summary should be submitted.
- NOTE:** Part B is to be submitted in hard copy only.
- Part C:** Update on efforts to increase response rates for the annual survey of occupational program graduates (applicable only to colleges that did not meet established minimum response rates for the 2002 survey of 2001 occupational graduates)
- NOTE:** If the college offers programs in areas for which issues of concern were noted in the *2002 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2001 Occupational Graduates*, be sure to address the issue(s) in the appropriate program review summaries reported in Part A.
- Other:** Copy of the college's current five-year program review schedule
- Due Date:** Submit **three** copies of the Fiscal Year 2003 Accountability/Program Review Report to the ICCB **no later than August 1, 2003.**
