Introduction

This *Addendum* contains supplemental instructions and reporting requirements for community colleges to address in their Fiscal Year 2005 Accountability/Program Review Reports. Information regarding the completion of Parts A and B, which are standard items in the annual report, is included in the *Community College PQP/Program Review Guide* (December 1993). Each year as a part of the Accountability/Program Review reporting process, the colleges have been asked to respond in Parts C and D of their reports to special inquiries based on issues from the Illinois Board of Higher Education and the Illinois Community College Board state-level initiatives.

Please note the following:

- 1. The Annual Results Report, now titled the *Performance Report*, required by the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) in response to goals established in the Illinois Commitment is no longer a part of ICCB's Annual Accountability/Program Review Report. ICCB will distribute the guidelines for the 2005 *Performance Report* in a separate communication.**
- 2. Part B - Action Summaries for Programmatic Improvements is no longer required.**
- 3. Part D - The Review of Undergraduate Education is no longer required.**

This *Addendum* includes instructions for preparing reports related to:

- Instructional program review summaries (Part A).
- Information from the *2004 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2003 Career and Technical Education Program Graduates* (Part C).

The *Addendum* also contains the following attachments that should be helpful as the colleges pursue their Accountability/Program Review activities:

- Attachment 1 – Schedule for occupational program review.
- Attachment 2 – Tables that show statewide information on credit hours, unit costs, enrollments, and completions by college for the instructional program areas that are to be reviewed during the year. Colleges will also find it useful to reference the tables included in the ICCB report, *2004 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2003 Career and Technical Education Program Graduates*, when analyzing program reviews.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005 ACCOUNTABILITY/PROGRAM REVIEW REPORT

Part A: Instructional Program Review Summaries (Analyses)

Colleges should use the *Community College PQP/Program Review Guide* (December 1993) for directions for Part A of the report. (Contact Becky Sanders at 217-785-0081 or bsanders@iccb.state.il.us if you need a copy of the *PQP/Program Review Guide*.) The following forms from Part A should be included in the Fiscal Year 2005 Accountability/Program Review Report from the college:

Form A-1 for occupational programs

1. A separate Form A-1 should be completed for each occupational program (by 6-digit CIP code) scheduled for review during fiscal year 2005. ***Programs that share 6-digit CIP codes may be included on the same summary report. Do not include a Form A-1 summary if your college does not offer programs in this CIP category.*** A schedule of the programs to be reviewed each year is attached for your use.
2. In addition, a Form A-1 should be completed for any occupational program that was reviewed during fiscal year 2005, and for which further review was indicated. ***Please indicate this is in follow-up to last year's recommendations on your summary report.***
3. Be sure to indicate curriculum information, *NOT course information*, in the table at the end of Form A-1 for occupational programs.

Form A-2 for academic disciplines

A separate Form A-2 should be completed for each academic discipline reviewed during fiscal year 2005.

Additional information to be included on each Form A-1 and A-2:

Goal 5 of the Illinois Board of Higher Education's *Illinois Commitment* states, "all academic programs will systematically assess student learning and use the assessment results to improve programs." Therefore, the following information regarding the assessment of student learning should be included in the program review summary submitted for each occupational program (Form A-1) and for each academic discipline (Form A-2) reviewed during 2004-2005:

- **Occupational Programs (Form A-1)**
 - ▶ **Briefly describe the process(es) the college has in place to ensure that students demonstrate mastery of the program's stated learning objectives prior to program completion (for example, assessment through portfolio review, capstone course, team project, written/performance test, or industry/state certification/licensure examination).**

- ▶ **Briefly describe how the college uses the results of this assessment for continuous quality improvement of the curriculum and student learning. Provide data if possible.**
- **Academic Disciplines (Form A-2)**
 - ▶ **Briefly describe the process(es) the college has in place to ensure that students demonstrate mastery of the stated learning objectives for the discipline individually and/or as it relates to the general education curriculum (for example, assessment through portfolio review, capstone course, comprehensive examinations, or identification of outcomes for key courses).**
 - ▶ **Briefly describe how the college uses the results of this assessment for continuous quality improvement of the curriculum and student learning. Provide data if possible.**
- **If program level assessment for a particular occupational program or academic discipline is not sufficiently established to provide the requested information, briefly describe the process(es) being developed and the anticipated implementation schedule.**

Form A-3 for developmental education

A separate Form A-3 should be completed for each developmental program reviewed during fiscal year 2005. Developmental programs include Adult Basic and Adult Secondary Education, English as a Second Language, and Developmental Studies.

Other: Form A-4 for Academic and Student Support Programs, Form A-5 for Overall Academic Functions, Form A-6 for Administrative Functions, and Form A-7 for Public Service Functions should be submitted only if the college reviewed the relevant functional area during fiscal year 2005.

IMPORTANT: While the primary purpose of program review is to ensure that programs are of high and continuing quality, the process is also a critical means of being accountable to students and others. The summaries of program reviews should provide strong evidence that recommendations for quality improvements for programs are linked directly to the findings of a rigorous program review process. In addition, summaries of program reviews should provide a continuous accountability loop by including information regarding the outcome(s) of recommendations from the previous review of each program.

**Part C: Occupational Program Reviews – Analysis of Information from the
2004 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2003 Career and Technical Education Program
Graduates**

This section of the *Accountability/Program Review Report* calls for an institutional analysis of information presented in the *Follow-Up Study of Career and Technical Education Program Graduates* distributed to the community college system each October. The follow-up study contains responses obtained from occupational program graduates of selected programs on a standardized student survey, thereby providing a critical “customer” perspective. Data from the survey are an important consideration as colleges evaluate the need, quality, and cost of specific occupational curricula during program review. Graduate response rates must be strong for these evaluations to be meaningful. *Therefore, minimum response rates have been set: a 50 percent response rate must be achieved by those colleges surveying 30 or more graduates; a 60 percent response is required for those institutions contacting less than 30 graduates.*

Colleges that did not meet the appropriate criterion for the 2004 survey of fiscal year 2003 occupational graduates should give special attention to increasing these rates for the coming year. These colleges should provide a brief update on their efforts to increase response rates in Part C of their Fiscal Year 2005 Accountability/Program Review Report.

Issues identified for particular programs in the 2004 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2003 Career and Technical Education Program Graduates should be addressed in individual program review summaries (Section A-1), as appropriate. - NOTE:** If the college offers programs in areas for which issues of concern were noted in the *2004 Follow-Up Study of Fiscal Year 2003 Career and Technical Education Program Graduates*, be sure to address the issue(s) in the appropriate program review summaries reported in Part A.
