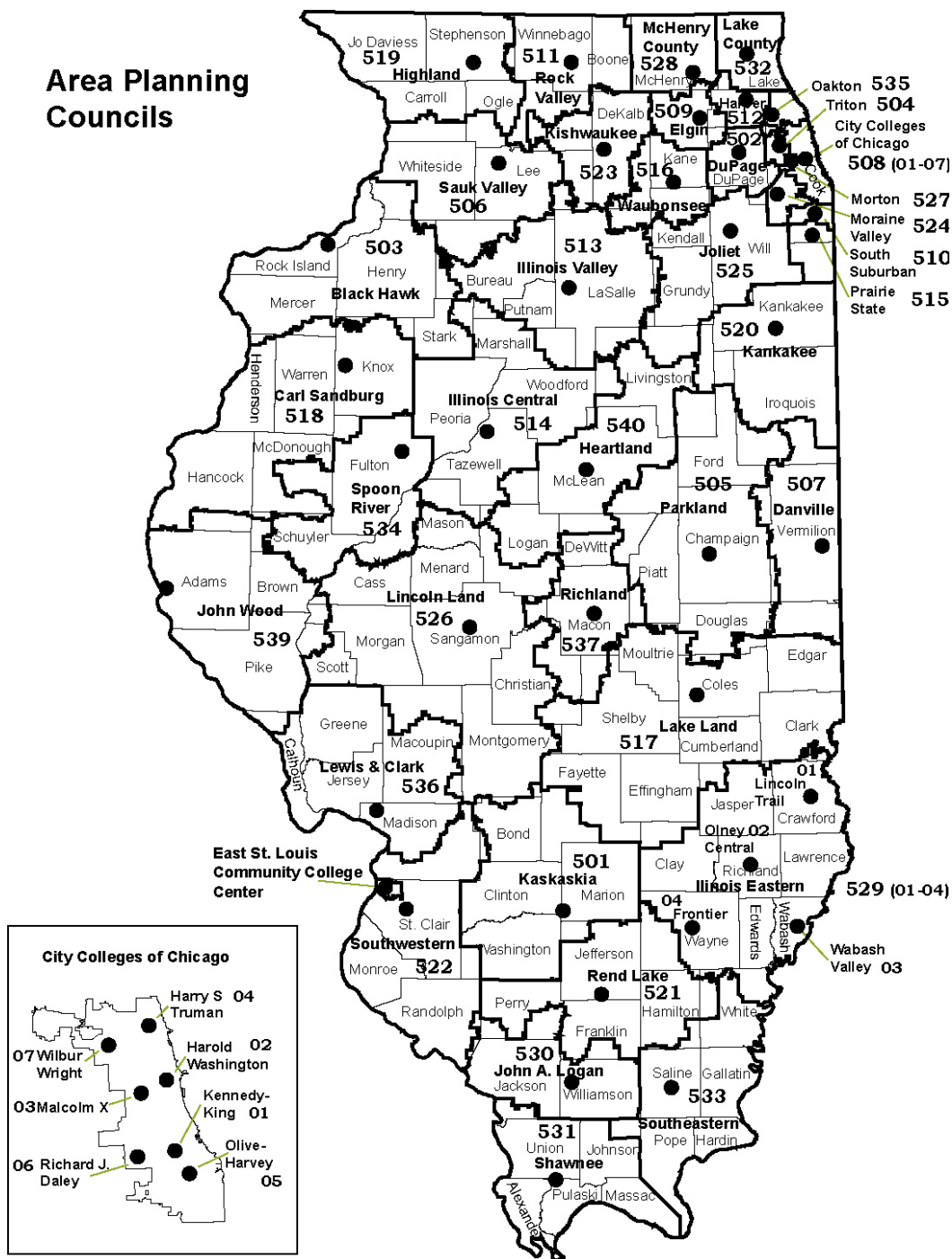

## INTRODUCTION

This is the ninth publication of a factbook on Adult Education and Family Literacy. This document contains data and characteristics about Adult Education and Family Literacy programs from fiscal year 2010 and is designed to serve as a reference document. The data source for the tables is the **Data and Information System Illinois (DAISI)** system, the approved data collection system for Adult Education and Family Literacy. The parameters for learners to be included in the factbook are a minimum of 7.5 hours of instruction which is the state reporting minimum attendance threshold. The federal reporting requirements reflect a different threshold of 12 hours of instruction.

This publication provides information about students and allocations. All data reflect fiscal year 2010 except trend Table 17 (fiscal years 2006-10). Table 1, Table 2 and Tables 6 through 14 are based on unduplicated enrollment in DAISI. Table 3 is based on duplicated enrollment in DAISI, meaning a learner can be counted more than once if enrolled in more than one type of instruction. Tables 4, 5, and 6 are based on pre-test results in DAISI. Table 15 is based on units of instruction in each type of instructional category in DAISI. One unit of instruction equals fifteen hours of enrollment. Table 16 is based on Adult Education and Family Literacy state and federal allocations. Table 17 is based on fiscal years 2006-07 unduplicated data in the **STudent Administrative Information Reporting System (STAIRS)** and fiscal years 2008-10 unduplicated data in DAISI.

Adult Education is defined as instruction and support services below the postsecondary (college) level for individuals who have attained 16 years of age; who are not enrolled or required to be enrolled in secondary school under state law; and who:

- lack sufficient mastery of basic educational skills to enable the individuals to function effectively in society;
- do not have a secondary school (high school) diploma or its recognized equivalent, and have not achieved an equivalent level of education; or
- are unable to speak, read, or write the English Language.

In the Illinois Community College Board's strategic plan, *The Promise for Illinois Revisited* directly addresses the need for Adult Education and Family Literacy. The mission states, "Economic and demographic changes are dramatically increasing the need for adult education, literacy, and English as a Second Language (ESL) programs. Millions of Illinois residents lack the level of literacy skills they need to obtain good jobs, perform well on the job, and to function well in an increasingly complex society. There is a direct correlation between higher literacy levels and higher income, remaining employed, children's success in school, and individual and family health. Large numbers of immigrants have come to this country seeking education, work, and a higher quality of life, yet many do not have the English literacy or technical skills they need to realize their goals. To address the scope and diversity of need for adult education and literacy skills takes community colleges, public schools, community-based organizations, and others working together to provide the education and services needed by a wide diversity of adult learners." <http://www.iccb.org/pdf/PromiseRevisited2006.pdf>

The Illinois Community College Board will work with the adult education community to strengthen efforts to develop strategies and obtain resources to support the following actions:

- Implement a funding process that more accurately reflects statewide need while maintaining a network of multiple service providers, the diversity of provider types, and services to all geographic areas of Illinois.
- Maximize state and federal resources to assure there is adequate and stable funding that will facilitate program quality and growth.
- Utilize the expertise of the current system of diverse providers, stakeholders, and state leadership in developing policies and procedures that will be responsive to the emerging needs of adult basic, adult secondary, and ESL students.
- Promote the use of data for program quality and improvement, determining program success, building learner success in meeting individual goals including secondary completions, transition to postsecondary education or training, and obtaining employment.
- Continue Illinois' participation in national leadership projects that promote quality, accountability, research-based practices, and provide adult education programs with access to state-of-the-art technology to expand service options and instructional delivery methods to students.
- Increase access to ESL and citizenship instruction to meet the need of persons moving to the United States, new citizens, and employers who increasingly rely on foreign-speaking workers.
- Establish effective administration of the GED Testing Program, working with Regional Offices of Education, test administrators, and adult educators to identify and address needed improvements.
- Continue the development and dissemination of innovations in adult education instruction.
- Increase awareness of, and involvement in, collaborative workforce and economic development initiatives at the local, regional, and state level.
- Increase grant opportunities to support adult education.

## DEFINITIONS

### INSTRUCTION IN ADULT EDUCATION

Adult Basic Education (ABE) – curriculum consists of approved courses designed to bring a student from grade zero through the eighth-grade competency level, as determined by standardized testing. Beginning level courses cover grade zero through the fifth-grade competency level. Intermediate level courses include grade six through the eighth-grade competency level. Each level of courses covers each content area. The curriculum is designed to accommodate the concept of open-entry/open-exit, individualized instruction and includes courses in general basic skills; reading, literacy, and communication skills; computational skills; workforce/employability skills; life skills; career exploration/awareness skills; workplace literacy; and family literacy/parenting.

Adult Secondary Education (ASE) – curriculum consists of approved courses designed to bring a student from grade nine through the twelfth-grade competency level, as determined by standardized testing. The curriculum is designed to prepare a student to achieve a GED (General Educational Development). The curriculum is designed to accommodate the concept of open-entry/open-exit, individualized instruction and includes courses in general, basic skills; academic and intellectual skills; reading, literacy, and communication skills; computational skills; workforce/employability skills; life skills and career exploration/awareness skills; workplace literacy; and family literacy/parenting. Foreign Language GED (Spanish or French) includes instruction designed for an adult who is literate in a foreign language and has sufficient education in that language to achieve a Foreign Language GED. Foreign Language ABE instruction or Native Language literacy is not fundable. Other than Foreign Language GED, all other classes must be taught in English.

English Literacy/English as a Second Language (ESL) – curriculum consists of approved courses designed to include instruction in English for those whose native language is not English. Beginning, intermediate, and advanced courses include a curriculum in listening, speaking, reading, and writing using the English language. Other courses using the English language may include instruction in life skills, citizenship education, career exploration, employability skills, workplace literacy, family literacy, and EL/Civics. Student levels are based on proficiency as measured by ICCB-approved standardized tests. The curriculum is designed to accommodate the concept of open-entry/open-exit, individualized instruction.

Vocational Skills Training – consists of ICCB AEFL-approved courses that include short-term, secondary-level vocational specific training that provide entry level workforce skills which may lead to employment. AEFL funds can provide no more than 12 units of instruction over the lifetime of a student's enrollment in an ICCB AEFL-approved program.

High School Credit – curriculum consists of approved courses offered in collaboration with locally approved school districts. Upon satisfactory completion, the student must meet the requirements of the locally approved school district for graduation.

## **EDUCATIONAL FUNCTIONING LEVELS FOR ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (ABE), ADULT SECONDARY EDUCATION (ASE), AND ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)**

Adult Basic Education Levels – These categories are used to identify students enrolled primarily in basic education courses in the lower to middle functioning levels. These classifications only include students whose primary or native language is English.

- Beginning ABE Literacy = test levels 0 to 1.9.
- Beginning Basic Education = test levels 2.0 to 3.9.
- Low Intermediate Basic Education = test levels 4.0 to 5.9.
- High Intermediate Basic Education = test levels 6.0 to 8.9.

Adult Secondary Education Levels – These categories are used to classify students enrolled primarily in courses designed for preparation for the General Educational Development Examination (GED) or in high school level courses (includes test levels 9.0 to 12.9). These classifications only include those students whose primary or native language is English.

- Low Adult Secondary Education = test levels 9.0 to 10.9.
- High Adult Secondary Education = test levels 11.0 to 12.9.

English as a Second Language – These categories are only used for students whose primary or native language is not English or who come from an environment where a language other than English is spoken in the home and are experiencing sufficient difficulty speaking, reading, writing or understanding English that require assistance to meet social, educational and work demands.

- Beginning ESL Literacy = test levels CELSA NA / BEST Literacy 0-20 / BEST Plus Below 401.
- Low Beginning ESL= test levels CELSA NA / BEST Literacy 21-52 / BEST Plus 401-417.
- High Beginning ESL = test levels CELSA 20-23 / BEST Literacy 53-63 / BEST Plus 418-438.
- Low Intermediate ESL= test levels CELSA 24-29 / BEST Literacy 64-67 / BEST Plus 439-472.
- High Intermediate ESL = test levels CELSA 30-41 / BEST Literacy 68-75 /BEST Plus 473-506.
- Advanced ESL = test levels CELSA 42-70 / BEST Literacy 76-78 / BEST Plus 507-540.



## **TYPES OF PROVIDERS**

Community Based Organizations (CBOs) providing services in Adult Education and Family Literacy in Illinois are nonprofit formal organizations within communities/ neighborhood settings delivering formal education and support services for adult learners, youth and/or families. Some CBOs are recognized for having a close relationship with a particular immigrant population and possess unique qualifications to meet the special needs of these individuals. These organizations provide skill building instructional and support services to help individuals acquire additional skills. In Illinois Adult Education and Family Literacy, CBOs are primarily located in the Chicago area.

Community Colleges (CCs) are public two year postsecondary institutions offering educational programs and services to all individuals with an ability to benefit from the instruction. Illinois has a comprehensive community college system offering instruction at all levels of adult education and literacy through college level education and training. The highest offerings are two year associate degrees in transfer and career/technical programs. In Illinois there are 48 community colleges organized within 39 districts. The City Colleges of Chicago and Illinois Eastern Community College are multi-college districts. <http://www.iccb.org/colleges.html>

Correctional Institutions - The Department of Corrections APC 428 provides educational and vocational instruction to inmates and youth confined to departmental facilities. In addition, APC 428 contracts with colleges and universities for advanced instruction. The educational programs provided to the Juvenile Division cover both the elementary and secondary levels. Students who are eligible receive special education instruction and remedial services. The educational programs provided to adult inmates cover elementary, secondary, and advanced levels. The Mandatory Education Provision of 1987 mandates inmates performing below the sixth-grade level in math and reading skills must receive a minimum of ninety days of Adult Basic Education (ABE) instruction. <http://www.idoc.state.il.us/>

Faith-Based Organizations – non-profit organizations associated with a faith community or multiple faith ministries.

Public Universities – Southern Illinois University is the lone public university Adult Education provider. <http://www.siu.edu/~adulted/index.htm>

Public Schools provide educational services to students, have an assigned administrator, receive public funds as its primary support, and are operated by an education agency. <http://nces.ed.gov/pubs2001>

Regional Offices of Education (ROEs) are administrative entities which operate under the leadership of an elected regional superintendent of schools. Some regions are based on a single county while others encompass multiple county units. ROEs serve as an intermediate link for elementary and secondary education and partner in the delivery of Adult Education and Family Literacy in the state of Illinois. Regional superintendents serve

as educational agents for the state within their respective geographic regions. Among other responsibilities, they are responsible for GED testing, certification renewals, legislation, grant management and educational programming for local K-12 school districts. <http://www.isbe.net/regionaloffices/>

### **AREA PLANNING COUNCILS (APCs)**

Area Planning Councils (APCs) are legislatively authorized (*Illinois School Code* (405/2-4)) to provide for the development and coordination of adult education programs in a specified region of the state. APCs were developed to promote integration of service delivery, avoid duplication of services, maximize available resources, and provide accessibility to those needing service. Generally, APCs coincide with the boundaries of community college districts.

The State Plan for Adult Education requires all programs receiving Adult Education and Family Literacy funds to participate in their local APC. Recognizing that serving this population of adults often means serving their families, all providers of programs are encouraged to participate in their local APC. The Area Plan developed by an APC covers a multi year planning period. APCs are encouraged to include representation from other service providers (e.g., Illinois Department of Human Services, Local Workforce Investment Boards, Child Care Resource and Referral agencies, etc.), and area businesses and industry.

APCs are required to meet at least twice during a fiscal year but most meet more often. The following entities are entitled to one representative on the APC: each school district within the APC boundaries maintaining either grades K-12 or 9-12; each regional superintendent of schools, the majority of whose region is included within the boundaries; and the community college.

### **OTHER DEFINITIONS GROUPED TOPICALLY**

DAISI – the Data and Information System Illinois (DAISI) is the approved data collection system for Adult Education and Family Literacy implemented in fiscal year 2008. DAISI replaced STAIRS as the data collection system.

STAIRS – the Student Administrative Reporting System (STAIRS) was the approved data collection system for Adult Education and Family Literacy in Illinois prior to fiscal year 2008.

National Reporting System for Adult Education – The National Reporting System (NRS) for Adult Education is an accountability initiative for federally funded adult education and family literacy programs. NRS consists of a series of measures to assess the impact of adult education instruction. NRS specify data collection methodologies and include reporting procedures and forms. <http://www.nrsweb.org/>

Family Literacy – an integrated, intensive service for at-risk families that must include, but is not limited to, the four components (adult education, parenting education, parent/child

activities, and child education) of family literacy. Only three components (adult education, parenting education, and parent/child activities) can be funded by ICCB Adult Education and Family Literacy funds. The fourth component (child education) must be funded by an appropriate child education partner.

EL/Civics Instruction – includes integrated English literacy and civics education to immigrants and other limited proficient populations which allows participants to effectively participate in the education, work and civic opportunities of the United States of America. EL/Civics is an educational program that emphasizes conceptualized instruction on the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, naturalization procedures, civic participation, and U.S. history and government to help students acquire the skills and knowledge to become active and informed parents, workers and community members.

Workplace Literacy – literacy services that are offered for the purpose of improving the productivity of the workforce through the improvement of literacy skills.

Disabled - Learner has a record of, or is regarded as having, any type of physical or mental impairment or disability that substantially limits or restricts one or more major life activities including walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, learning, and working. (NRS)

Full-time Employment - Learners who work 37.5 hours or more per week as a paid employee.

Part-time Employment - Learners who work less than 37.5 hours a week as a paid employee.

Unemployed - Learners who are not working, but are actively seeking employment. The individual has made specific efforts to find a job and is available for work. (NRS)

Not in Labor Force - Learners who are not employed and are not actively seeking employment. (NRS)

Public Assistance Recipient - Learner is receiving financial public assistance from Federal, State, or local government agencies, including Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), food stamps, refugee cash assistance, old-age assistance, general assistance, and aid to individuals who are designated as blind or individuals who are totally disabled. (NRS)

Work-based Project Learner - Learner acquires the skills in a short-term learning course designed to teach specific work-based skills. A short-term course is typically an instructional program of at least 12 hours but no more than 30 hours duration. (NRS)

Correctional Facility - Any prison, jail reformatory, work farm, detention center, or any other similar Federal, State, or local institution designed for the confinement and rehabilitation of criminal offenders. (NRS)

Community Corrections - A community-based rehabilitation facility or halfway house. (NRS)

Other Institutional Setting - Any other medical or special institution. (NRS)

Rural - An area that has less than 2,500 inhabitants and is outside an urbanized area. (NRS)

Urban - An urbanized area that has a population of 50,000 or more in a city and adjacent areas of high density. (NRS)
