### FALL 2016 OPENING ENROLLMENT SURVEY RESULTS

**Statewide Results.** Overall, Illinois Community College System opening Fall 2016 enrollments continue to decline. These opening enrollments reflect the end of the regular fall registration period which is usually the 10th day of class. Fall 2016 enrollments show a decrease in headcount (-3.9 percent) and a decrease in the number of Full-time Equivalent enrollments (-4.1 percent) compared to last year.


Systemwide, 303,896 students enrolled at Illinois Community Colleges in credit coursework in Fall 2016. The number of students enrolling in credit courses at Illinois community colleges as of the end of regular registration for Fall 2016 is 12,259 fewer than in Fall 2015.

Table 1 provides system-wide comparative fall census enrollment counts for the last five years as well as 2001 and 2006. The Illinois Community College System experienced record-level Fall enrollments in recent years with peak headcount enrollment during the Great Recession. Statewide opening headcount enrollments and Full-time Equivalent (FTE) enrollments have continued to decrease since that time (six consecutive years). Fall 2016 headcount enrollments have also decreased 13.3 percent since Fall 2006 and 10.4 percent since Fall 2001. Fall FTE enrollments are at their lowest level since Fall 1989 (N = 174,437). Fall 2016 FTE enrollments have decreased 10.4 percent from Fall 2006 and decreased 3.6 percent from Fall 2001.

Community colleges educate and train many part-time students. FTE figures reflect the total number of credit hours being taken by students divided by 15, which is the number of semester hours traditionally considered a full-time class load. The FTE enrollment was 176,374 in Fall 2016. Statewide FTE enrollments are down the equivalent of 7,496 full-time students (FTE -4.1 percent) from Fall 2015.

These opening enrollments reflect the end of the regular fall registration period which is usually the 10th day of class. These preliminary counts are from the web-based Fall 2016 Enrollment Survey. Results are verified as the detailed Fall Enrollment (E1) data submissions are finalized.

**Results by College.** The externally attached Table 2 provides comparative information by college for Fall 2012 through 2016 headcount enrollments. A one-year comparison between Fall 2015 and Fall 2016 among the 48 community colleges shows that there are nearly five colleges with enrollment decreases for every college that reported an enrollment gain. Thirty-seven colleges reported headcount decreases of one percent or more. Eight colleges exhibited headcount enrollment increases of one percent or above. The remaining three colleges experienced little or no change (less than one percent).

The externally attached Table 3 provides college level comparative data on FTE enrollments for the most recent five-year period. Over the past year, FTE decreases

are posted by 34 colleges, and 6 colleges reported increases. Eight colleges experienced little or no change in FTE.

**Students in Correctional Facilities.** Two Illinois community colleges furnished instructional services to correctional facilities during the Fall semester of both 2015 and 2016. The externally attached Table 4 provides a comparison of correctional and non-correctional 2015 and 2016 Fall headcount enrollment for each community college. In the latest data, there are 203 students in correctional facilities, which accounts for 0.1 percent of the statewide headcount. Proportionately this was similar to Fall 2015 (0.2 percent). An examination of only student enrollments in correctional facilities reveals a headcount decrease of 72.9 percent ( $N = -545$ ). **Non**-correctional headcount enrollment decreased (-3.7 percent,  $N = -11,714$ ) from Fall 2015 to Fall 2016.

The externally attached Table 5 shows a comparison of FTE enrollment – correctional and non-correctional students – for Fall 2015 and Fall 2016 by community college. Students in correctional facilities accounted for 0.1 percent ( $N = 101$ ) of the overall FTE enrollment in Fall 2016 which is proportionately similar to Fall 2015 (0.1 percent). An examination of only student enrollments in correctional facilities shows that incarcerated student FTE decreased from last year (-63.3 percent or  $N = -174$  FTE), while the enrollment declined in non-correctional population enrollments (-4.0 percent or  $N = -7,322$  FTE).

**Online Enrollment by College.** Online instruction is an important part of the delivery of instructional programs in the community college system. Fall 2016 is the ninth year that online enrollments have been reported from all colleges in the Opening Fall Enrollment Survey. The externally attached Tables 6 and 7 provide unduplicated and duplicated headcount online enrollment for Fall 2012 through Fall 2016. There are 101,696 duplicated online enrollments and 63,446 unduplicated online enrollments for Fall 2016. Duplicated online headcount enrollments increased 5.9 percent (+5,638) from Fall 2015, while Fall 2016 unduplicated online enrollments increased 4.2 percent with 2,554 more students than Fall 2015. Based on unduplicated beginning of term counts, in Fall 2016 online headcount enrollments (unduplicated) accounted for 20.9 percent of overall headcount enrollments which is an increase from last year (19.3 percent).

Table 8 provides opening online FTE enrollments for Fall 2012 through Fall 2016. There are 19,287 online FTE enrollments in Fall 2016, which is a slight decrease over Fall 2015 (0.0 percent or -3 FTE). In Fall 2016, online FTE enrollments accounted for 11.4 percent of overall opening FTE enrollments, which is a slight increase from Fall 2015 (10.5 percent).

The Fall 2016 online unduplicated headcount is 1.0 percent above its corresponding 5-year average ( $N = 62,841$ ). The Fall 2016 online duplicated headcount is also above its 5-year average (+5.3 percent;  $N = 96,547$ ). The online FTE for Fall 2016 is slightly below its 5-year average ( $N = 19,371$ ).

**Additional Background.** Fall opening enrollment information for credit-generating students are recorded by the colleges at the end of the regular fall registration period, which is typically the 10th day of class. Opening fall enrollment data are gathered from postsecondary institutions nationwide. Historically, these counts provide a "snapshot" of opening fall term enrollment for year-to-year and institution-to-institution comparisons. The diversity of the community college system and its students is not fully captured in these opening enrollment snapshot data. Community college flexible scheduling (e.g., modules, other intensive late start classes, etc.) is necessary to accommodate student schedules and compete successfully in the marketplace. Hence, enrollment trends are more fully captured through use of annual data.
