FALL 2017 OPENING ENROLLMENT SURVEY RESULTS

Statewide Results. Consistent with national community college enrollment trends, the Illinois Community College System opening Fall 2017 overall enrollment is down compared to the previous year. Illinois Community College System Fall 2017 enrollments show a decrease in headcount (-3.5 percent) and a decrease in the number of Full-time Equivalent enrollments (-3.7 percent) compared to last year. These opening enrollments reflect the end of the regular fall registration period which is usually the 10th day of class. The Illinois public university overall undergraduate FTE is showing a decline as well in Fall 2017 at -2.3 percent as described in the Illinois Board of Higher Education [Fall Enrollment Report](#).

Systemwide, 293,533 students enrolled at Illinois Community Colleges in credit coursework in Fall 2017. The number of students enrolling in credit courses at Illinois community colleges as of the end of regular registration for Fall 2017 is 10,640 fewer than in Fall 2016.

Table 1 provides system-wide comparative fall census enrollment counts for the last five years as well as 2001 and 2006. The Illinois Community College System experienced record-level Fall enrollments in recent years with peak headcount enrollment during the Great Recession. Statewide opening headcount enrollments and Full-time Equivalent (FTE) enrollments have continued to decrease since that time (seven consecutive years). Fall 2017 headcount enrollments have decreased 16.3 percent since Fall 2006 and 13.4 percent since Fall 2001. Fall FTE enrollments are at their lowest level since Fall 1985 (N = 166,674). Fall 2017 FTE enrollments have decreased 13.5 percent from Fall 2006 and decreased 7.0 percent from Fall 2001.

Community colleges educate and train many part-time students. FTE figures reflect the total number of credit hours being taken by students divided by 15, which is the number of semester hours traditionally considered a full-time class load. The FTE enrollment was 170,294 in Fall 2017. Statewide FTE enrollments are down the equivalent of 6,503 full-time students (FTE -3.7 percent) from Fall 2016.

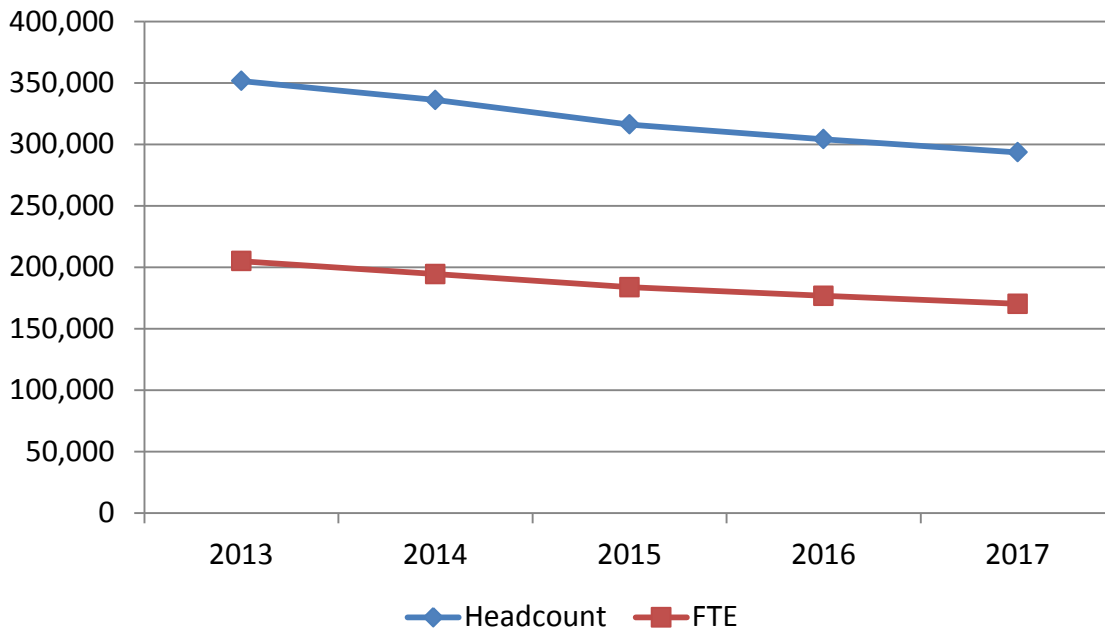


Figure 1: Opening Fall Headcount and FTE Enrollment, 2013-2017

These opening enrollments reflect the end of the regular fall registration period which is usually the 10th day of class. These preliminary counts are from the web-based Fall 2017 Enrollment Survey. Results are verified as the detailed Fall Enrollment (E1) data submissions are finalized.

Results by College. The externally attached Table 2 provides comparative information by college for Fall 2013 through 2017 headcount enrollments. A one-year comparison between Fall 2016 and Fall 2017 among the 48 community colleges shows that there are four and one-half colleges with enrollment decreases for every college that reported an enrollment gain. Thirty-six colleges reported headcount decreases of one percent or more. Eight colleges exhibited headcount enrollment increases of one percent or above. The remaining four colleges experienced little or no change (less than one percent).

The externally attached Table 3 provides college level comparative data on FTE enrollments for the most recent five-year period. Over the past year, FTE decreases

are posted by 36 colleges, and 6 colleges reported increases. Six colleges experienced little or no change in FTE.

Students in Correctional Facilities. Two Illinois community colleges furnished instructional services to correctional facilities during the Fall semester of both 2016 and 2017. The externally attached Table 4 provides a comparison of correctional and non-correctional 2016 and 2017 Fall headcount enrollment for each community college. In the latest data, there are 142 students in correctional facilities, which accounts for 0.0 percent of the statewide headcount. Proportionately this was similar to Fall 2016 (0.1 percent). An examination of only student enrollments in correctional facilities reveals a headcount decrease of 30.0 percent (N = -61). **Non**-correctional headcount enrollment decreased (-3.5 percent, N = -10,579) from Fall 2016 to Fall 2017.

The externally attached Table 5 shows a comparison of FTE enrollment – correctional and non-correctional students – for Fall 2016 and Fall 2017 by community college. Students in correctional facilities accounted for 0.0 percent (N = 61) of the overall FTE enrollment in Fall 2017 which is proportionately similar to Fall 2016 (0.1 percent). An examination of only student enrollments in correctional facilities shows that incarcerated student FTE decreased from last year (-39.6 percent or N = -40 FTE), while the enrollment declined in **non**-correctional population enrollments (-3.7 percent or N = -6,463 FTE).

Online Enrollment by College. Online instruction is an important part of the delivery of instructional programs in the community college system. Fall 2017 is the tenth year that online enrollments have been reported from all colleges in the Opening Fall Enrollment Survey. The externally attached Tables 6 and 7 provide unduplicated and duplicated headcount online enrollment for Fall 2013 through Fall 2017. There are 99,119 duplicated online enrollments and 62,903 unduplicated online enrollments for Fall 2017. Duplicated online headcount enrollments decreased 2.5 percent (-2,577) from Fall 2016, while Fall 2017 unduplicated online enrollments decreased 0.9 percent with 543 fewer students than Fall 2016. Based on unduplicated beginning of term counts, in Fall 2017 online headcount enrollments (unduplicated) accounted for 21.4 percent of overall headcount enrollments which is an increase from last year (20.9 percent).

Table 8 provides opening online FTE enrollments for Fall 2013 through Fall 2017. There are 19,840 online FTE enrollments in Fall 2017, which is an increase over Fall 2016 (2.9 percent or +553 FTE). In Fall 2017, online FTE enrollments accounted for 11.7 percent of overall opening FTE enrollments, which is an increase from Fall 2016 (10.9 percent).

The Fall 2017 online unduplicated headcount is 0.1 percent above its corresponding 5-year average (N = 62,826). The Fall 2017 online duplicated headcount is also above its 5-year average (+1.5 percent; N = 97,610). The online FTE for Fall 2017 is above its 5-year average (+2.1 percent; N = 19,439).

Additional Background. Fall opening enrollment information for credit-generating students are recorded by the colleges at the end of the regular fall registration period, which is typically the 10th day of class. Opening fall enrollment data are gathered from postsecondary institutions nationwide. Historically, these counts provide a "snapshot" of opening fall term enrollment for year-to-year and institution-to-institution comparisons. The diversity of the community college system and its students is not fully captured in these opening enrollment snapshot data. Community college flexible scheduling (e.g., modules, other intensive late start classes, etc.) is necessary to accommodate student schedules and compete successfully in the marketplace. Hence, enrollment trends are more fully captured through use of annual data.
