## INTRODUCTION

This is the twelfth publication of a comprehensive data book by the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB). This document contains data and characteristics of the Illinois public community college system and is designed to serve as a basic reference. No analysis of the data is intended in this document. The data are obtained from various surveys and studies conducted by ICCB staff and from the colleges' annual MIS submissions.

This year the major data tables from the data book will again be available to colleges in computer-readable form using the Lotus 1-2-3 electronic spreadsheet program. To receive the data book in computer-readable form: (1) send a blank, formatted 5 1/4 or 3 1/2 inch disk that can be read by an IBM compatible microcomputer; (2) specify whether the disk is high density or regular density; (3) specify the release of Lotus 1-2-3 your college uses – either 1A, 2.01, or 3.1 are available; (4) enclose a self-addressed envelope with return postage; and (5) forward your request to the Production Controller, Data Processing Department, Illinois Community College Board, 509 South Sixth Street, Room 400, Springfield, Illinois 62701-1874.

This document contains annual data for fiscal year 1991 and fall term data for 1991 (fiscal year 1992). Enrollment data and faculty and staff data are collected during the fall term each year; thus, these data are fall term 1991 (fiscal year 1992). Budgeted operating finance and facilities data are for the current year, fiscal year 1992. Audited financial data, unit cost data, annual enrollments, and graduate data are for the past fiscal year, fiscal year 1991.

This publication provides information about 1) students, 2) faculty and staff, 3) annual enrollment and completion, 4) operating finance, and 5) capital construction. Each of these areas constitutes a section of this document. Several tables summarize data from more detailed reports that have been published separately. The objective of this document is to provide useful summaries of data for community college districts in one reference document. If you have requests for other data or suggestions for additions or deletions, please contact the ICCB office.

Special acknowledgment is extended to the personnel of the colleges for their cooperation in completing surveys and providing the ICCB with computer-readable data on a timely basis.

Table 1 on the next page is a summary profile of selected statistics for the 40 Illinois public community college districts. The map on page ix shows the geographic location of each college district.
