- What do users (students) think is working and not working as remedial education is delivered today?
- Which student populations are most vulnerable in the status quo?
- What circumstances support success for these student populations?
- What factors contribute to success for all students?
- What are implications for this task force?

### **Pair and Share Activity**

- Turn to your neighbor and discuss ways you think design thinking can help the Task Force to attain its desired goals
- Brainstorm ideas for using design thinking, including opportunities and challenges
- Generate 2-3 ideas to share with the whole Task Force
- Give a copy of your notes to the facilitator so that all ideas are recorded, synthesized and shared with the whole Task Force
