INTRODUCTION

This is the third publication of a comprehensive data book by the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB). This document contains data and characteristics of the Illinois public community college system and is designed to serve as a basic reference. No analysis of the data is intended in this document. The data are obtained from various surveys and studies conducted by the ICCB staff and from the colleges' annual MIS submissions.

This document contains annual data for Fiscal Year 1982 and fall term data for 1982 (FY 1983). Enrollment data and faculty and staff data are collected during the fall term each year; thus, these data are Fall Term 1982 (FY 1983). Budgeted operating finance and facilities data are for the current year, Fiscal Year 1983. Audited financial data, unit cost data, annual enrollments, and graduate data are for the past fiscal year, Fiscal Year 1982.

This publication contains information about 1) students, 2) faculty and staff, 3) instructional programs, 4) operating finance, and 5) capital construction. Each of these areas constitutes a section of this document. Several tables summarize data from more detailed reports that have been published separately. The objective of this document is to provide useful summaries of data for community college districts in one reference document. If you have requests for other data or suggestions for additions or deletions, please contact the ICCB Office.

Special acknowledgment is extended to the personnel of the colleges for their cooperation in completing surveys and providing the ICCB with computer-readable data on a timely basis.

Table 1 on the next page is a summary profile of selected statistics for the 39 Illinois public community college districts. The map on page viii shows the geographic location of each college district.

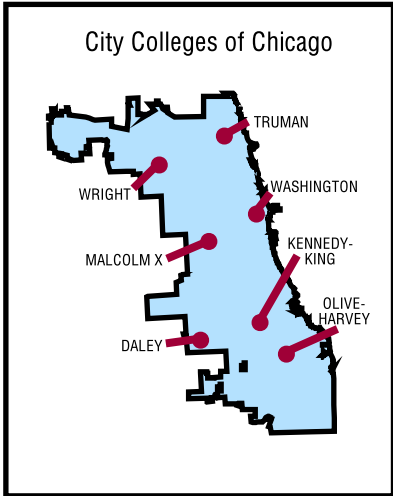
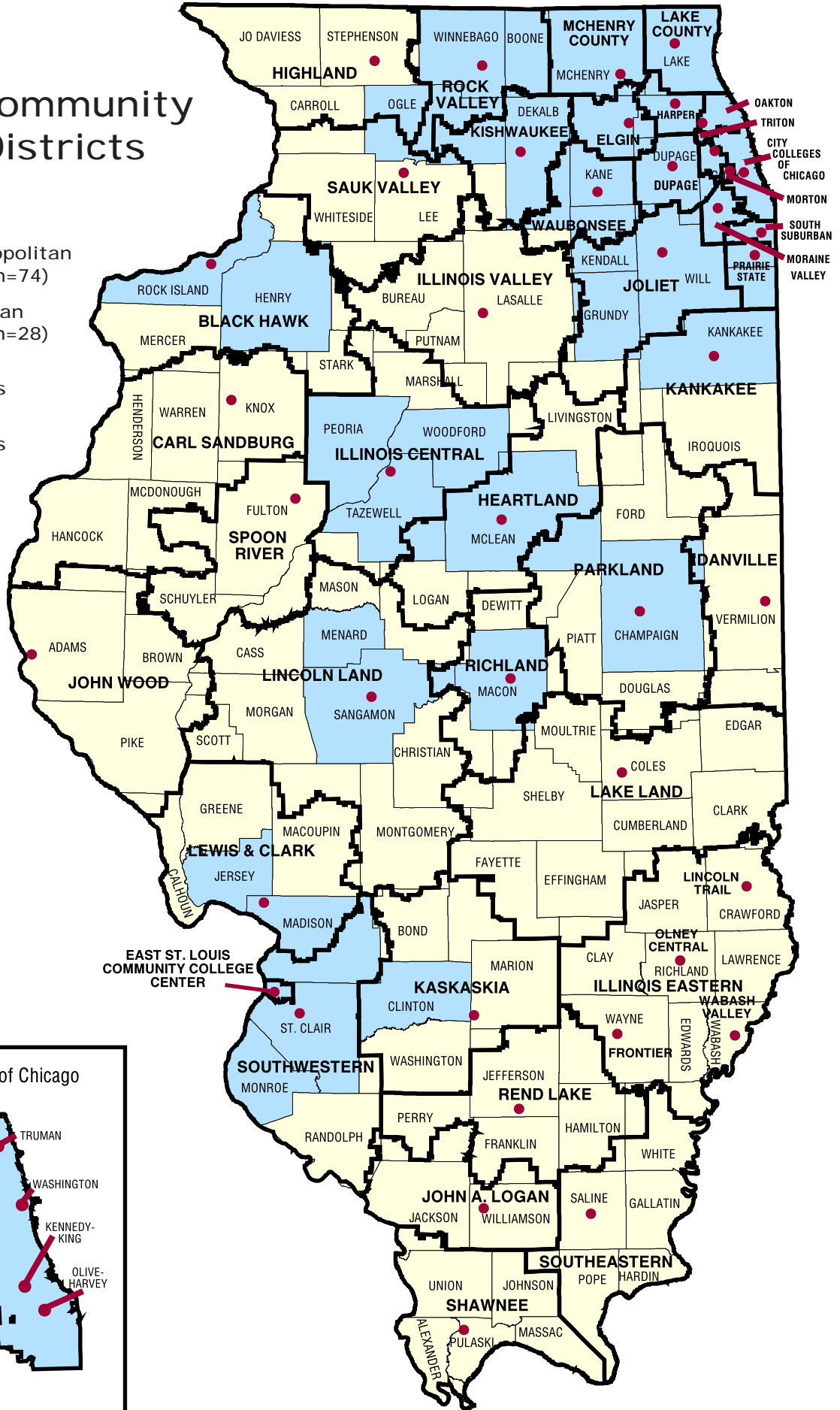

Section I

STUDENT CHARACTERISTICS

This section includes data on headcount and full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollments in Illinois public community colleges.

The public community colleges of Illinois enroll more than 50 percent of all students enrolled in higher education in the State of Illinois. The diverse population of the communities that the colleges serve is reflected in the student characteristics shown in this section.

The tables show student enrollments based on opening counts (10th-day enrollments) for a given term. Opening enrollment counts are a snap-shot count at the end of the regular registration for the fall term and do not include many students who enroll for courses which start later in a term.

Table I-1 shows that the annual unduplicated headcount enrollment in Illinois public community colleges for fiscal year 1982 was 791,496. This is more than twice as many students as the number who were enrolled in the fall of 1981.

Table I-2 shows the fall 1982 student headcount enrollment by instructional program area. Thirty percent of the students were enrolled in baccalaureate transfer programs, 30 percent in occupational programs, 0.8 percent in remedial/developmental programs, 15 percent in general studies programs, 6 percent in vocational skills programs, and 10 percent in adult basic education/adult secondary education programs.

Table I-3 shows the fall 1982 student enrollment by sex and type of attendance. Fifty-seven percent of the enrollments in Illinois public community colleges were women. Part-time students accounted for 72 percent of the enrollments.

The data in Table I-4 shows fall 1982 enrollment by age categories and provides the median age of students for each public community college. The median age for fall 1982 students was 25.8 years. This is down 1.1 years from the fall 1981 median age of 26.9.

Table I-6 shows that approximately 14 percent of fall 1982 students were classified as sophomores. Fifty-seven percent of the fall 1982 enrollments were classified as freshmen.

Table I-11 shows the trends in community college headcount enrollments from fall 1973 through fall 1982. Table I-12 lists the trends of FTE enrollments for the same ten-year period.

Section II

FACULTY AND STAFF DATA

The tables in this section show information about the number of faculty and staff employed by the public community colleges of Illinois and their compensation. The salary and staff data were collected in fall 1982 and reflect averages for FY 1983.

Table II-1 shows the number of instructional teaching faculty members during fall 1982 who were hired to teach in the classroom. The data in this table are shown by sex and employment status.

Table II-2 shows the total number of administrative staff by sex. Administrative staff include both academic and general administrative personnel such as the President, Dean of Instruction, Dean of Student Services, Director of Financial Aid, Director of Counseling, and other similar administrative positions.

Table II-3 shows the number of full-time and part-time other professional staff by sex employed in each community college. Other professional staff includes counselors, librarians, and other instructional support staff. Table II-4 shows the same information for classified or civil service type staff.

The average contractual base salaries paid to full-time teaching faculty, full-time administrative staff, and full-time other professionals are shown in Table II-5.

Table II-6 shows the average class size for lecture/discussion classes and laboratory classes. Table II-7 shows a percent distribution of classes by size for each community college.
