



ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENT FALL ENROLLMENT


- Fall 2023 Illinois community college headcount enrollments increased by 5.7 percent from the previous Fall.
- During the same timeframe, nationally, community college enrollments increased by 4.4 percent.





ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE FALL 2022 TO FALL 2023 ENROLLMENT % CHANGE BY REGION


- Enrollment increased Fall 2022 to 2023 in eight of ten regions.
- The region with the highest increase was Central at +14.3 percent which consists of Lincoln Land and Richland.
- The Northeast region, with the largest regional enrollment (168,131 in Fall 2023), experienced an increase of +6.2 percent as compared to Fall 2022.





FALL STUDENT ENROLLMENTS BY INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM AREA IN ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGES


• Career and Technical Education (+10.4 percent) and Adult Education (+20.8 percent), both mostly dependent on in-person instruction, had substantial enrollment increases.






FALL STUDENT ENROLLMENTS BY AGE IN ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGES

- Seven out of ten students at Illinois community colleges are under 25 years of age.
- The proportion of students under 25 year of age has remain unchanged over the last three years.









FALL STUDENT ENROLLMENTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY IN ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGES

- More than one-half (52 percent) of the Fall 2023 student population in the Illinois Community College System are minority students.
- Much of the increases in enrollment over the last three years has been driven by Latinx (+17.0 percent) and Black or African American (11.4 percent) students










FALL STUDENT DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENTS IN ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGES


• Dual credit headcount enrollments increased 8.4 percent from Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 and 18.9 percent from Fall 2021 to Fall 2023.





FALL STUDENT ONLINE COURSE ENROLLMENTS IN ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGES

• Online education remains a prevalent and flexible form of course delivery with 42 percent of students enrolling in at least one online course in the current Fall as compared to Fall 2019 (pre-pandemic) at 24 percent.
