## National Apprenticeship (Schedule Change)


#### The Future of NAW




How long has your college offered apprenticeships?




What is the current status of your Information Technology (IT) apprenticeship program(s)?




How many IT apprentices are currently active?






Do employers provide release time for IT apprentices to complete coursework during their workweek?



### Training Domain: Apprenticeships in Credit Programs Employer



At minimum, the employer will need to pay the student's hourly wage (min \$16.20/hour) which is determined by the employer. For highly invested employer, they also cover the apprentice's salary and the full cost of tuition and books (which would cost approx. \$10k)



Participant Recruitment & Assessment

We recruit students for open opportunities based on the employer's education requirements and/or specific tech program alignment. We also provide initial screening to provide employers the best qualified candidates.



#### Customizable

Apprenticeships are completely customized to meet the employer's needs in their talent pipeline.



Can range from 1 semester to 4 semesters (2 years) depending on what type of credential the student is seeking. Courses are offered in person, virtual, or hybrid.



Integrated Services

CCC students have access to City Colleges campus resources from computer labs, Wellness Centers, Career Development Centers, advisors, discounted U-Pass, food pantries, to career closets.



#### **Program Variety**

Credit offerings and stackable credentials in cybersecurity, software development, networking systems and technology, and web development.










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## IT Apprenticeships at City Colleges

#### **Challenges/Opportunities**

- Interestingly only 1 employer is a "tech" company. Majority of tech apprentices are placed in tech roles at non-tech companies
- Grapple with competitiveness of local (noneducation-aligned) tech apprenticeship market
- Integrate with existing or new employer-led apprenticeships (Google, IBM, Accenture)

#### We've identified the following challenges for our IT Apprenticeships:

- Wages for IT positions in Southern Illinois are low compared to state and national averages.
- According to EMSI data: The national median salary IT occupations is \$93,071, compared to \$81,746 in Southern Illinois.
- Fewer IT job openings in Southern Illinois
- Employers looking to fill full-time positions which hinders the ability of students enrolled in IT degree programs to work and go to school.
