
ICCB Apprenticeship Survey






How many years has your college offered apprenticeships?







How are your apprenticeships funded?




11. Do employers pay for the tuition and fees on behalf of apprentices?







If so, do employers pay direct (rather than reimburse) students for the tuition and fees on behalf of apprentices?




If so, do employers pay direct (rather than reimburse) for the cost of books and materials on behalf of apprentices?
